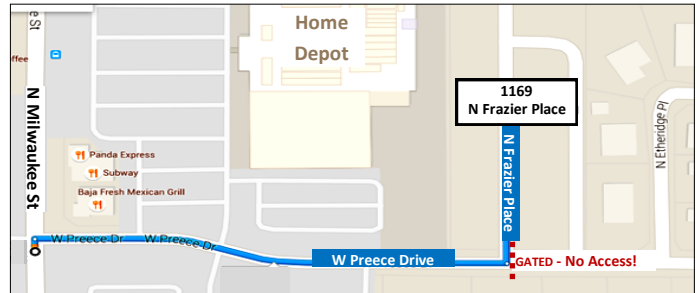
Your donation of time and labor helps us provide simple, decent, affordable homes to hard working families in Ada County. We promise a fun, productive day for all of you!

Time 7:45am - 3:00pm

Our day begins at 7:45 with a warm welcome and a brief safety training. We take a lunch break at 11:30. We ask that each person stay for the entire scheduled time so that we can be sure of completing the tasks planned for the day and allow time for clean up.

Footwear



Good quality work boots are recommended, with a heavy, treaded sole that offers support, traction, and protection.



Light hikers and athletic shoes are acceptable. Duties performed may be determined by footwear.



Clothing

Long pants offer more protection than short pants. Layers of clothing are recommended so that the worker can adjust to the temperature. No loose jewelry please.

Equipment

Each volunteer should bring water in a refillable container for water. We will provide tools; those who own tool belts may opt to bring their own. **Please bring work gloves.**

Lunch

Each volunteer will need to bring a sack lunch.

Age Limit

All volunteers on our construction site must be 18 years of age or older.
